Since 1836 Holland & Sherry has continued to supply prestigious tailors and luxury brands with some of the finest cloths in the world. Stephen George Holland and Frederick Sherry began the business as woolen merchants at 10 Old Bond Street, London, specializing in both woolen and silk cloths. In 1886 Holland & Sherry moved premises to Golden Square, at the time the epicenter of the woolen merchanting trade.

By 1900 the firm was exporting to many countries, it was around that time a sales office was established in New York. In the early part of the 20th century, the United Kingdom, Europe, North and South America were the dominant markets for the company. Amongst other distribution arrangements, there was a Holland & Sherry warehouse in St. Petersburg, Russia – a successful market prior to the revolution and now successfully renewed.

By 1982 the business moved to Savile Row, which remains as our registered head office. In 1968 Holland & Sherry bought Scottish cloth merchant, Lowe Donald, based at Peebles, in the Scottish Borders and decided to locate their distribution to the purpose built warehouse there. Of all the cloth merchants of Golden Square, which were established in the late 1800's, only Holland & Sherry remains. Over the decades we have purchased nearly twenty other wool companies.

Today, the Peebles warehouse houses our main sales, customer service, ordering, shipping, cutting, bunchmaking and design operations where we are constantly engaged in research for ever finer and more luxurious fibres and fabric qualities; sourcing the finest natural fibres, ranging from Super 240's, cashmere to pure worsted Vicuña.

Our cloths are woven in the time honoured way to assured quality and good taste. A bespoke tailored garment in luxury Holland & Sherry cloth is truly an investment and always a pleasure to wear. Inspired by classic British styling, our City of London collection uses the traditional weaves of twill, herringbone and birdseye.

Inspired by classic British styling, this collection uses the traditional weaves of twill, herringbone and birdseye in classic patterns such as pin stripe, chalk stripe, glen plaid and houndstooth, offering choice and variety.

Luxury Wool Worsted Flannel

This comprehensive collection of worsted flannels comprises classic chalk stripe, houndstooth, windowpane and glen check designs in a series of traditional colours, and is a complement to Holland & Sherry's Classic Flannel bunch HS 1775.

The origin of the word flannel is uncertain, but a Welsh origin has been suggested, as fabric similar to flannel can be traced back to Wales, where it was well known as early as the 16th century.

The qualities in this collection are woven from yarns that have been spun on the worsted spinning system, commonly known as combed flannels. Unlike carded flannels, combed flannels are less hairy, more durable and often lighter in weight making them suitable for most temperate climates.

Flannel fabrics are both comfortable and warm to wear, they have excellent drape and crease recovery properties making them one of the most popular choices for autumn and winter attire.

SHERRY TWEED Pure New Wool

Inspired by the beauty of the rolling hills and the dramatic moorlands of the Scottish Borders, this collection takes its name from the locality.

Home to Holland & Sherry, the Scottish Borders has a longstanding association with tweed fabric, which was primarily developed within the region of the Tweed river. The river had a rich source of minerals that made the water soft; it also had very few impurities, making it an ideal water source for finishing the fabric after the weaving process. This pure, mineral-rich water is still used for the same purpose today and is the reason why traditional Scottish tweed continues to enjoy a worldwide reputation.

The attraction of tweed lies in its wonderful colourations. These are achieved by blending together several different colours in one yarn. Once the yarn is interlaced to create the woven fabric, up to six colours can be present in the ground cloth, imbuing the cloth with its special, enchanting vibrancy.

The designs of this comprehensive collection draw on the lasting appeal of a traditional, authentic cloth, capturing the essence of classic tweed whilst incorporating a contemporary colour palette. Warm and soft to touch, attractive to look at and durable, contemporary yet traditional, this classic collection of fabric from the Tweed Valley is the ultimate tweed.

- The finest cashmere fibres have been gathered from the saddle of the cashmere goat by carefully combing the goat's fleece during the spring months.
- The cashmere has then been carefully blended with 18µ merino wool to produce a range of opulent melange colours that are beyond compare.
- The combing and blending of the fibres continues, gently removing any short staple fibres from the blend.
- Once all the longer fibres are in perfect alignment and the desired level of colour achieved, the fibres are gently twisted together in a soft 'S' direction.
- The soft 'S' twist in the finished yarn and the gentle scour that the cloth undergoes contribute to the unparalleled softness, lightness and warmth of the cloth.

DAKOTA Cavalry Twills, Bedford Cords and Whipcords

In this collection Holland & Sherry presents a selection of classic weaves, including whipcords, cavalry twills and Bedford cords in a series of classic and contemporary colours. The fabrics in this range typify British tradition and are suitable for city or country wear, including suits, trousers, riding breeches and overcoats.

We begin the bunch with an all-wool cavalry twill. A cavalry twill can be identified by a steep double twill formation with pronounced weft grooves between each twill line. Fabrics woven from a cavalry twill construction were traditionally worn by the military but now it's the suitable choice for all outdoor country sports and casual city attire.

Next, we have a small selection of Bedford cords in traditional colours. The Bedford cord takes its name from the town of Bedford in England. It is traditionally a heavy fabric that can be identified by its warped faced rib effect.

Following the Bedford cords are a series of whipcords in a variety of weights; something to suit all. A whipcord is a dense fabric in the warp direction, having more threads per inch than the weft. When the weft is inserted, the weave structure forms a steep bold twill line, giving the cloth its character. Whipcords traditionally lend themselves to pursuits associated with the outdoors.

BLAZER BUTTON COLLECTION

Holland & Sherry's brass blazer buttons are all handmade in England.

Each button is cut from solid brass and individually die-stamped in the traditional way, and then rough-buffed by hand in preparation for plating, as appropriate, in either 9ct gold, silver, antique silver or bronze finishes.

The majority of our buttons also feature enamel detail in one, two or three different colours. Each enamelling is applied one at a time using a fine paintbrush, before being fired in a kiln at a very high temperature to ensure permanence. After cooling, the button is carefully inspected and the raised detail is burnished by hand.
