PRODUCT SPECIFICATIONS

Inverness is a full-grain leather made from European bull-hides. As a full-grain product, the hide's surface has not been sanded or corrected with pigmentation, which adds a level of natural durability while letting the surface idiosyncrasies (nicks, stretch marks, wrinkles etc.) shine. Inverness is aniline-dyed with an oilrubbed finish, so it offers a beautiful sheened surface that will patina over time. As a medium pull-up leather, Inverness will lighten and darken when upholstered and with continued use. This is the character of the goods and in no way considered a flaw. It's a great option for clients who appreciate the natural aging process of leather, but who are also looking for a durable product suited for residential to high traffic areas.

CLEANING & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Occasionally dust with a soft, dry cloth. Blot spills immediately — never rub. If cleaning is required, use a pH-balanced cleaner made for semi-aniline or pigmented leather, applied with a soft cloth in gentle circular motions. Never use alcohol, bleach, acetone, baby wipes, or household cleaners, as these strip the protective topcoat. For deep stains, ink, or significant discoloration, consult a professional leather cleaner.
