Braemar is a vegetable re-tanned, semi-aniline leather – this means that organic materials (e.g. tree bark, leaves, and branches) were used in the processing of these hides. This technique results in colors that are rich and deep in natural, earthy tones. A light level of pigmentation has been added to enhance the leather's natural sheen, although you will see some nuances and inconsistency in color tone. These are not defects, in fact, they are the beauty of this particular leather. The vegetable re-tannage imparts a firm hand which makes it ideal for applications such as table tops and desk inlays. The epitome of Holland & Sherry style – this is a classic leather with a smooth, elegant hand and a masculine edge. Suitable for residential application.

CLEANING & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Occasionally dust with a soft, dry cloth. Blot spills immediately — never rub. If cleaning is required, use a pH-balanced cleaner made for semi-aniline or pigmented leather, applied with a soft cloth in gentle circular motions. Never use alcohol, bleach, acetone, baby wipes, or household cleaners, as these strip the protective topcoat. For deep stains, ink, or significant discoloration, consult a professional leather cleaner.
