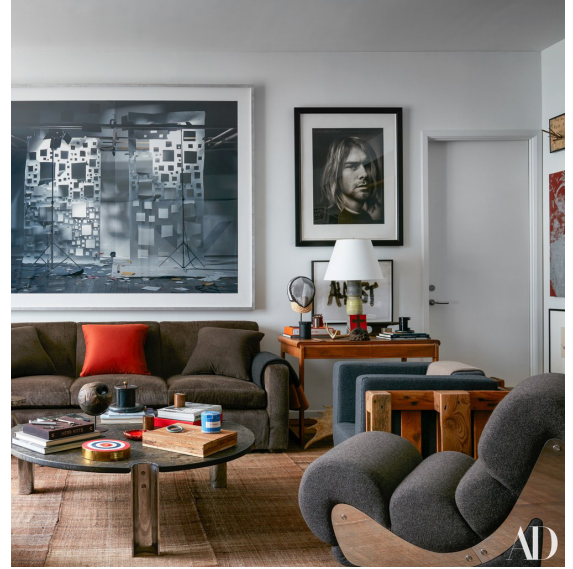


# BOILED WOOL CHAMONIX

## KNIT BACKING

Do not knit back. Reinforce upholstery seams. An ample seam allowance and overlock stitching / serging is recommended.

## CLEANING & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Professional dry clean only, delicate treatment. Do not wash. Do not bleach. Do not tumble dry. Iron on low setting only. To remove dust or light dirt, gently brush with an upholstery brush or lightly vacuum with an upholstery attachment.

Upholstery, drapery, wall upholstery, accessories, soft goods, and suitable for commercial use.
