The Perth Collection is produced on European bull hides with an enhanced grain. The manufacturing process of Perth, which includes vacuum-drying the hides, creates a smooth, tight grain that will afford any workroom superior yields. Perth is defined by its uniform color and durability; it is recommended for high traffic areas and contract settings. This leather is easy to maintain.

CLEANING & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Since a pigmented leather like Perth is durable, the leather usually does not require much care. For normal maintenance, dust with a soft and dry cloth. Stains can be treated with a damp cloth or cotton wool using a mild non-detergent liquid soap and water solution. Apply evenly with a damp soft white cloth or nonabrasive sponge, wiping away any excess with a clean dry cloth. Do not oversaturate the cloth; cloth should be damp not wet. Never use abrasive or aggressive products like solvents, stain removers, etc. Do not use shoe cleaning products. Do not steam as the steam may affect the leather and its properties. In every case, everytime that a new product is used for the cleaning apply it to a "hidden" area to test its effectiveness and to avoid damages where more visible.
