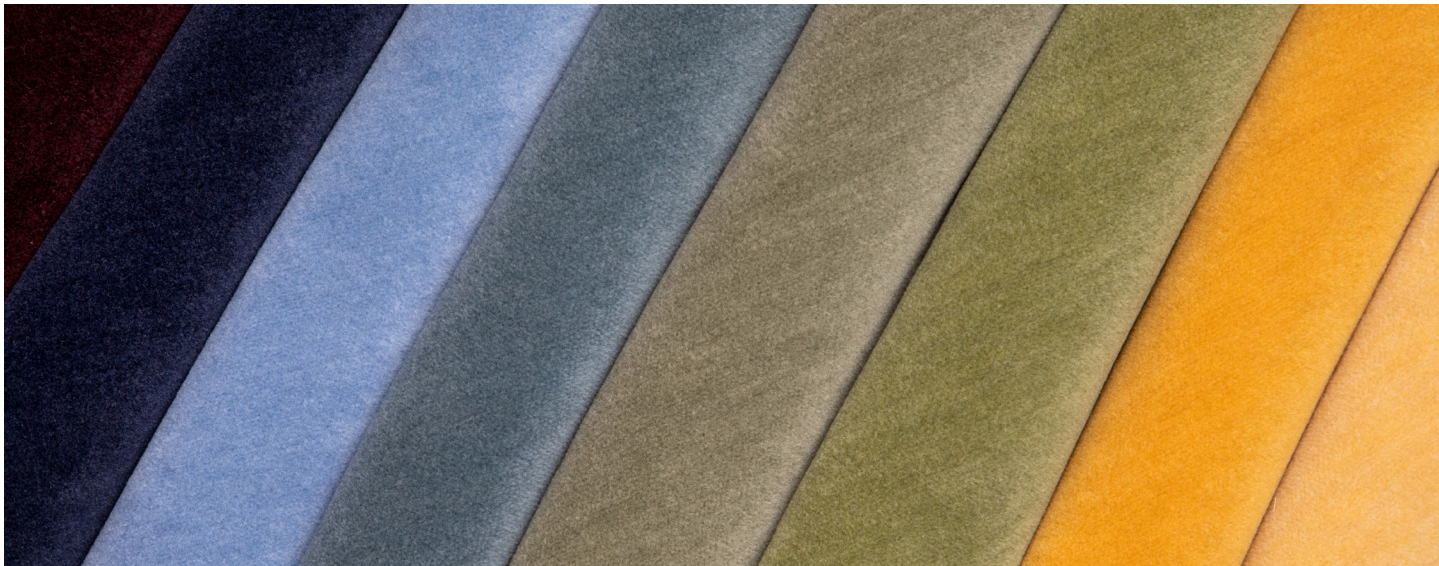


MÉLANGE WOOL VELVET RAMBOUILLET



This sturdy 100% wool pile velvet is woven with our exclusive mélangé wool yarn. The fine merino, non-directional pile has a natural stria that gives this fabric a richness and texture not commonly associated with wool velvet. Eight new colors have been added to grace this already stunning color palette.

KNIT BACKING

Knit backing is not recommended. Reinforce upholstery seams. An ample seam allowance and overlock stitching / serging is recommended.

CLEANING & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Professional dry clean only. Do not wash. Do not bleach. Do not tumble dry. To remove dust or light dirt gently brush or vacuum, with an upholstery attachment, in the direction of the pile.

VELVET PILE

The Rambouillet velvet has a non-direction pile that stands straight on end. When running your hand across the surface of the velvet you cannot detect a direction or a nap in the velvet pile. It is important to note the direction of the cloth during cutting and manufacturing to make sure that all cut pieces of the velvet are running in the same direction. Applying the velvet in mixed directions could result in shade difference within the upholstered piece.

END USE

Upholstery, drapery, accessories, soft goods, and wall upholstery.

VELVET HANDLING

Clients and their workrooms need to take caution when handling velvets before upholstering as any wrong handling can damage the velvet pile.

- Always keep the velvet roll untouched and in the suspended shipping box until use.
- Do not stand the shipping box on its end. The box should rest horizontally.
- Do not handle the fabric portion of the roll as this may crush the velvet pile. Two people should lift the roll out of the suspended velvet box holding the ends of the tube.
- The velvet roll should not sit on a work surface for an extended period of time as this may leave the bar mark across the width of the fabric from the weight and the pressure of the roll.
- While velvet is not in use it should be stored suspended in the velvet box.
